

Household Appliance Grant Program for Storm Recovery:

It was announced on the call today that the governor has authorized an \$8 million dollar grant, administered by NYSERDA for "essential appliances and equipment" lost in the storm. This covers energy efficient "refrigerators (\$350), clothes washers (\$250), clothes dryers (\$250), dehumidifiers (\$100), furnaces (\$2,000), boilers (\$2,500), and qualified hot water heaters (gas storage water heaters, heat pump water heaters, electric water heaters, \$400). Only appliances and equipment that replace those damaged in the storms are eligible for rebates (with the exception of dehumidifiers that can either replace a damaged dehumidifier or have been purchased to reduce humidity resulting from the storm). The New York Storm Relief Rebate Program is providing this assistance exclusively for New York State residents that are not receiving compensation from FEMA or insurance companies for these appliances or equipment."

Applications will be available beginning Monday, Sept 19.
